The APEGA Foundation was established in 1996 as the arms-length charitable organization of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA) to fund STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) outreach programs, provide financial assistance to students and encourage more post-secondary capacity.

Today, they continue to work to influence the career choices of young Albertans. To inspire the next generations of dreamers and problem solvers, they are also focused on growing understanding of the importance of, and societal impact of, engineering and geosciences.
