APEGA past-president Alberta Order of Excellence inductee

Edmonton – APEGA past-president Dr. Steve E. Hrudey, P.Eng., FEC, FGC (Hon.), FCAE, FRSC, FSRA, IWAF will be inducted into the Alberta Order of Excellence, Alberta’s highest civilian honour, in Edmonton this October.

An Edmonton native now residing in Canmore, Hrudey joins 15 other APEGA professional members inducted into the order: Dr. Norbert Morgenstern, P.Eng. (1991), Dr. Ernest Pallister, P.Geoph. (1996), Dr. Donald Stanley, P.Eng. (1998), Harley Hotchkiss, P.Geol. (1998), Eric Newell, P.Eng. (2004), John Poole, P.Eng. (2004), Harry Hole, P.Eng. (2006), Allan Markin, P.Eng. (2008), Doc Seaman, P.Eng. (2008), Reza Nasserri, P.Eng. (2010), Irving Kipnes, P.Eng. (2012), Griffin Lloyd, P.Geol. (2012), past-president Dr. George Govier, P.Eng. (2013), Stan Grad, P.Eng. (2015), and Dr. Jacob Masliyah, P.Eng. (2015).

A University of Alberta faculty of medicine and dentistry professor emeritus in analytical and environmental toxicology, Hrudey served for 13 years on the Alberta Environmental Appeals Board and served as board chair from 2005 to 2009. He served on 28 expert panels that addressed public policy issues, 10 of them as chair. Three higher profile panels included the Research Advisory Panel to the Walkerton Inquiry (2000–2002), the Expert Panel on Safe Drinking Water for First Nations (2006), and the Royal Society of Canada Expert Panel on Environmental and Health Impacts of Canada’s Oil Sands Industry (2009-2010).
