TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the option is available for parties to attend the hearing virtually. Should a party wish to attend the hearing virtually, they must make a written request to the Director of Enforcement, Erum Afsar on or before May 10, 2023 via email: hearings@apega.ca.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that MS Teams is the interface used for the virtual hearing. If a party would like to schedule a test environment to determine the necessary technological requirements are met for a virtual hearing, please send a written request on or before May 10, 2023, via email: hearings@apega.ca.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to *EGP Act – Part 5 – Section 56*, the aforementioned persons may appear and be represented by Legal Counsel at the preliminary application before the APEGA Discipline Committee.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to the *EGP Act – Part 5 – Section 58(1)*, that evidence may be given before the APEGA Discipline Committee in any manner that the Committee considers appropriate, and the Committee is not bound by the rules of law respecting evidence applicable to judicial proceedings.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to the *EGP Act – Part 5 – Section 61(3)*, that the Discipline Committee, on proof of service of the notice of investigation on the investigated person and the complainant, if any, may

- (a) proceed with the investigation in the absence of either or both of these persons, and
- (b) act on the matter being investigated in the same way as though either or both of those persons were in attendance.
